What is the Romans Road to Redemption?

Gospel of Jesus Christ

1 Corinthians 15:1–6

Now I would remind you, brothers, of the gospel I preached to you, which you received, in which you stand, and by which you are being saved, if you hold fast to the word I preached to you—unless you believed in vain.

For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures, and that he appeared to Cephas, then to the twelve. Then he appeared to more than five hundred brothers at one time, most of whom are still alive, though some have fallen asleep.

ABCs of Salvation



A- Admit you're a sinner

Romans 3:10 “As it is written: There is no one righteous, not even one.”

Romans 3:23 “For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.”

Romans 6:23 “For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life, in Christ Jesus our Lord.”

ABCs of Salvation



B- Believe Jesus is Lord

Romans 10:9-10 “If you declare with your mouth, ‘Jesus is Lord’ and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved.”

ABCs of Salvation



C- Call Upon his Name

Romans 10:13 “Everyone who calls upon the name of the Lord will be saved.”

God's Promise
